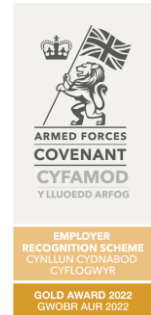

We are looking for someone with a desire and interest to work in a commercial vehicle maintenance and repair environment, who is willing to learn and develop their skills through a blended learning approach in both the workplace and college.

The Apprentice Vehicle Technician will work closely with our team of vehicle technicians, to receive on-the-job training and under supervision, will carry out repairs and maintenance to Service vehicles, plant and equipment as directed. Using schematic diagrams and problem solving techniques, you will carry out diagnosis and repairs, ensuring all work carried out is recorded correctly via completion of job cards and service maintenance records.

You will need to be an effective communicator with good organisational skills to meet deadlines. Mechanical work experience is desirable but training will be given to develop this knowledge and understanding, whilst also developing sound problem-solving skills to ultimately work independently using your own initiative. The successful candidate will either already hold or have the ability to obtain a full driving licence within the probation period.

The Fleet office and workshops are located in Llandudno Junction, but the role will include travelling to attend other Fire Service locations and sites in North Wales; this will be in a Service provided vehicle and will initially be with other Fleet employees. The Apprenticeship also includes the requirement to attend college on a day release basis.
